Bill Orris – 3 Time State Champion


In 1955 Bill won the 120 Yard High Hurdle and the 180 Yard Low Hurdle State Championship & the Drake Relays Title. In 1956, Bill won the 120 Yard High Hurdle State Championship.

Bill continued his education and track career at the University of Iowa, where he earned his Bachelors Degree in Civil Engineering, and was the Central Collegiate Champion in 1960.

Bill was an Area Engineer for Military Construction, in charge of 65 personnel. Bill retired in 1963.

The US Air Force awarded Bill the "Civilian Man of the year award in 1989.

Bill and his wife Bobbie live in Sacramento, CA. They have a son and a daughter, and two grandchildren.




Jerry Schartner

He has served as Lincolns Head Coach for 32 years, and is still their head coach. His record at Lincoln is 540W & 183L. Schartners Coaching Accomplishments include: 10 State Tournament Appearances – 14 Conference Titles – 3 Time State Coach of the Year – 6 Times Conference Coach of the Year – 6 Times District Coach of the Year – Once Regional Coach of the Year – Golden Plaque of Distinction – Hall of Fame in the Girls Coaches Association. Grand View College Hall of Fame – Coached 12 division 1 players – 52 of his players received College Basketball Scholarships. Jerry's wife Joan is deceased. He also has two daughters, and 5 grandchildren.
