And she certainly is appreciative of what we have provided her. I am also enclosing my response sent to her on behalf of our class. I am a bit plagued with having to think of what you can even say to a High School student that would be of any value to them.

Hopefully this gives you some information for your next edition of the **EHS Missing Link "56.**

You need to remind our class that we are still \$4,600 short of the \$30,000 minimum to assure a \$1,500 scholarship will be awarded annually into perpetuity from our class. If they send it to Community Foundation of Greater Des Moines for the East High Alumni Foundation, Class of 1956 fund, the person contributing will be eligible for an Iowa income tax credit of 25% of the amount of their donation. If they are not an Iowa resident to take advantage of the tax credit it is assignable. Their address is:
